

STORM WATER MS4 PERMIT SUMMARY

As presented to the Annual Meeting on April 10, 2007

Town of Dunn is participating in a Stormwater Permit Consortium with the Towns of Bristol, Cottage Grove and Pleasant Springs. Together we received a joint grant to help us comply with regulations of ch. 283 Wis Stats and subch. I of ch. NR 216 of the Wis. Adm. Code.

The following is a list of activities required of Dunn to meet the standards of our permit:

Public Education and Involvement

Submit a public education and outreach program
Submit public involvement and participation program

Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination

Adopt and submit illicit discharge ordinance
Submit illicit discharge response procedures
Complete initial field screening
Submit on-going field screening

Construction Site Pollutant Control

Submit construction site pollutant control ordinance
Submit construction site inspection and enforcement procedures

Post-construction storm water Management

Submit post-construction storm water management ordinance
Submit long-term maintenance procedures

Pollution Prevention

Submit pollution prevent program

Storm Water Quality Management

Submit evaluation of flood control structures
Submit assessment of compliance

Annual Report – submit annual report by March 31 of each year

Reapplication for Permit Coverage – reapply for MS4 permit by March 31, 2009


