

## **Important Information About Care at The Town Of Dunn Burying Ground**

**Safety.** When mowing and trimming at the burying ground, small items left on and around grave sites become hazardous projectiles for mowing procedures. For the safety of the operations staff, visitors and possible damage to surrounding tombstones, small items will no longer be allowed to be left on or around grave sites at any time. This includes, but not limited to: stones, coins, bottles and cans, knickknacks etc. Items left will be removed and disposed of.

**Spring Cleanup** to be done by April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.

**Fall Cleanup** to be done by November 1<sup>st</sup>. All planters (live or fake flowers), hooks, decorations, solar lights, knickknacks, etc. must be removed. Only military flag markers may remain. This is done for winter operations. Items that are not removed will be disposed of.

Christmas wreaths may be placed at the grave on thin wire stands only. NO shepherds hooks. Wreaths may be set at any time.
